Leadership Intern Program

Gamma Sigma Chapter of Sigma Theta Tau International (STTI) is soliciting applicants for the Leadership Intern Program. The selected intern will have opportunities to learn different strategies for decision making, activity planning, coordinating, and networking through participating in activities at the local, regional or national level.

Purpose:



To encourage future leaders to develop their leadership skills and insights within the framework of a local chapter



Mentor and develop new leaders into the operation and function of the organization

The leadership program is an outstanding opportunity for an interested individual to grow professionally and personally, to develop or expand leadership skills and to learn more about STTI and Gamma Sigma chapter.

Each February 1st, one intern shall be selected. The selection process consists of a two part application. All application packets (form A and B, and two recommendation forms) plus your curriculum vitae must be received on or February 1st of each year. The selected intern will be introduced at the annual Gamma Sigma Chapter Induction Ceremony in May for appointment to the intern position in June.

Eligibility: Inductees will have one year from induction to apply for leadership program.

The internship period extends over two years. The selected intern will be expected to:



Attend all general business meetings four times a year



Attend induction ceremony



Attend a minimum of 50% of board meetings



Participate in special events and projects



Participate in selected committee work



Commit to a leadership position at the end of the second year



Chapter will sponsor selected Intern(s) for attendance at chapter events.

The leadership program is a great opportunity for an interested individual to grow professionally and personally, and learn more about STTI and Gamma Sigma Chapter. We encourage you to apply for this program, or recommend a candidate who has the potential of being a nursing leader.
